Corrotherm Intl set for worldwide growth

Nickel alloy specialists Corrotherm International are expanding their business' global reach by opening up new branches around the world. They have expanded into

brand new markets with a new office in Busan, South Korea and have also added to their Middle East coverage by opening an office in Abu Dhabi to complement the existing one in Dubai. Both new branches are already making inroads into their market places, with enthusiastic staff on hand to help customers new and old. The Middle East will benefit further from a new Corrotherm office opening in Saudi in the near future, which will encourage even greater growth in this market place. Enviro permit granted to Outokumpu Tornio site

The Regional Administration of Northern Finland (PSAVI) has granted Outokumpu Tornio site an environmental permit for its operations. The permit will enable the commissioning of the extension to the ferrochrome production capacity already under construction in the autumn of 2012 as planned. The investment in ferrochrome production will double the ferrochrome production capacity to 540,000tns per year. The value of the entire investment is around EUR 440 million, of which over EUR 60 million will go into environmental investments. The investment will be implemented using the best available technology (BAT). This will ensure Outokumpu's position as a pioneer in

environmental matters also in the coming years. Outokumpu has for two consecutive years achieved the No. 1 place in the steel industry in the Dow Jones evaluation of the environmental efforts of the 342 companies studied.

DK Jones extends warehouse



DK Jones Ltd has announced that a new warehouse extension has been completed. This new extension of 5000sq/m, which increases their total covered warehouse space to 15,000sq/m, allows both an increased range of stainless steels and additional machining capacity. The range of stainless steel items now stocked includes Outlet Fittings (Olets) and High Pressure Forged Fittings, Nipples, Solid Bar and a range of Seamless Stainless Steel Pipe. Several new machines have now been installed for DK Jones's "in house" machining facilities including three new CNC machines plus two machines specially designed for the profiling of Olets. This investment in stock and equipment will enable machining of special Olets and High Pressure Forged Fittings from a large stock of high quality semi finished Forgings, Bar and Pipe thus ensuring a very quick delivery time for many standard and special items. In addition to supplying original manufacturer's certificates with every item, Positive Material Identification (P.M.I.) is available on all materials before dispatch.

Wärtsilä to supply ship designs

Wärtsilä has been contracted to supply the ship designs for three new platform supply vessels (PSVs). The contracts have been signed with Kleven Maritime AS, the Norwegian shipyard that will build the vessels, two of which will be owned by Atlantic Offshore and the other by Remøy Shipping. Both are Norway based companies. All three ships will be operated
